

Tempe Reserve Volunteer Duty

Saturday Morning (8am - 12:30pm) - 6 people required

During the morning shift, there needs to be at least <u>6 Volunteers</u> available at Tempe Reserve. The 6 people can be split up in different duties however there **MUST** be 6 volunteers at the park for this entire time slot.

Once you arrive, please report to the Amenities Building (Canteen Area) on the Airport side of Tempe Reserve and look for a MFC Club Official in an orange vest for further instructions.

Shift duties are divided into the below responsibilities:

BBQ (1 or 2 People required)

- Cook food on BBQ (Eggs, Bacon, Sausages, Onion etc)
- Eggs and Onions to be cooked on 1 BBQ, Bacon and Beef Sausages separate.
- Clean and Maintain BBQ and area
- Communicate with Canteen staff/volunteers if food is running low, to keep cooking etc.
- Check Gas Bottles, if running low, advise the Grounds keeper.

CANTEEN (2 people required)

- Assisting with preparation for BBQ and Canteen Service (cutting onions, bread, re-filling of sauce bottles and napkin holders)
- Serving customers etc.
- Cleaning/sterilizing benches and washing anything in the sink.
- Advising BBQ people when food items are running low.

GROUND OFFICIALS (3 people required, must wear ORANGE vest)

- Walking around the grounds/fields,
- Checking that <u>only yellow</u> vested officials (2 per team) are in the technical areas,
 - Checking/reporting for any incidents
 - Assisting with any field set ups (roping off fields, taking out signs, bin placement etc)
 - During the game time, keep an eye out on behaviour of spectators and parents towards the Game Leaders. If you see any irregular or inappropriate behaviour, you are authorised to intervene or call a Club Official to come over to the field.
